

Inter-Lakes Athletic Advisory Board
Meeting: 4/16/12 6:30 to 7:30 pm

Meeting Discussion:

1. Senior Athlete Sports Awards Update – Jeff Cloos
 - a. Hart's has been booked for Sunday, June 3rd. The next step is to get invitations out in early May to the senior student athletes and coaches. Hanna volunteered to assist Mr. Cloos if he needs help with the invitations.
 - b. The agenda needs to be worked on and if people have ideas for a guest speaker please let Jeff Cloos know. Tentative agenda for the evening will include a social/mingling period of approx. 30 minutes, welcome address by Mr. Cloos, meal/buffet dinner, recognition and special awards and maybe a guest speaker.
 - c. Former Inter-Lakes Booster Club funds and oversight of the remaining account balance has been transferred over to Jeff Cloos, Everett Bennett and Patti Kennelly and the Athletic Advisory Board. Some of the funds will be used to cover a portion of the senior athlete's award banquet and a nominal fee will be charged to parents that would like to attend with their child.

2. Update 2012-2013 Athletic Trainer Services
 - a. Jeff Cloos said that the funds for Athletic Trainer services didn't get into the school budget as Phil McCormack had promised the school board that no new programs/initiatives would be added to the budget. However, Jeff Cloos had a meeting with Dr. McCormack and Patti Kennelly to investigate alternatives to get the funds for these services for the athletes. Dr. McCormack approved Jeff Cloos to move forward with obtaining athletic trainer services and they will find funds from other sources that won't add to the 2012-2013 budgeted amounts.
 - b. Athletic Trainer services will be provided by Granite State Physical Therapy and will cover all "contact" sports game coverage for the high school, as well as some office hours, checking in at some practices and they will oversee the concussion baseline testing. The contact sports that will be covered by these services for the Fall and Winter seasons include Soccer, Football, Hockey and Basketball. Unfortunately the other sports during the Fall and Winter Seasons that aren't considered contact sports won't be covered during the 2012-2013 school year as well as the Spring sports at this time.
 - c. Granite State Physical Therapy will be providing one consistent person to provide the athletic trainer services to Inter-Lakes and Gilford High School, therefore this person will become a very familiar face to players, coaches and parents at our home events. When there is an overlap of home events

for both Gilford and Inter-Lakes, then there could be times we will see a substitute athletic trainer on-site fulfilling the responsibilities.

- d. Steve Olefson indicated that there are 2 home Nordic races held at Gunstock and in the past he has had a parent of one of his athletes that is a doctor that has been on-site during the races and has provided beneficial assistance when injuries occurred. Steve asked Jeff Cloos and Patti Kennelly if they would consider adding those 2 Nordic home events to the list of covered events for the Athletic Trainer and Jeff Cloos indicated he would do his best to obtain coverage for those 2 events.

3. Other discussion items

- a. Junior High Championship Track Meet on May 21st at 4 pm to be held at ILHS. Jeff Cloos asked if people would be interested in conducting a fundraiser at that event by selling T-shirts, drinks, baked goods, snacks etc. The group agreed this would be a good idea to help fund the senior athlete banquet and several people volunteered to assist, Patte Morrow, Carrie Roberge, Bill Irwin and Alison Duffield. Jeff Cloos asked Steve Olefson if he would be willing to make some design recommendations for the t-shirts. Short-sleeve t-shirts could be purchased for approximately \$7.50 each and sell for \$15.
- b. Request from the After-Prom Committee for donation to the evenings event for the seniors. The group discussed the donation options. Jeff Cloos indicated he had some athletic gear type items he would donate on behalf of the Athletic Board as prizes/gifts at the After Prom Party, such as visors, baseball hats, t-shirts etc.
